

UCCRC RECRUITMENT FUNDS

Any Department Chair or Section Chief recruiting new faculty with a primary cancer focus is welcome to approach the UCCRC for support. All requests for support must be accompanied by the attached form.

General Information:

Budget:

Depending on circumstances and the nature of the recruitment, the UCCRC is willing to provide supplements of varying amounts, ranging from \$25,000 - \$35,000 for one to three years, to much more substantive contributions.

Review Process:

Requests for recruitment funds will be reviewed by the UCCRC Cancer Advisory Committee. Decisions will be based on current availability of funds, extent to which the proposed recruit works in UCCRC-designated high priority areas (or has been specifically recruited to fill an identified gap), degree to which recruit is likely to participate actively in the cancer center (ie collaborate with other UCCRC members), and likelihood that recruit will be successful in obtaining independent grants in the future.

Progress Reports:

On an annual basis during the period of support, the UCCRC requests that the faculty member submit reports indicating their progress including efforts to secure external funding and publications (any publication resulting from the funded project should acknowledge the support of the University of Chicago Cancer Research Center and list the Cancer Center Support Grant number).
